Cleaning the Outside

Do not use abrasive products such as Scotch Brite or steel wool pads; they will scratch the surface.

The exterior of your Monogram Designer Collection Column Panel can be washed with warm sudsy water. Wipe the surface dry in the direction of the grain with a microfiber cloth.
